

# **Erasmus+ international centralised actions - What to expect in 2020**

The information below is only a snapshot of the main changes planned to the international dimension of Erasmus+ in call 2020. Applicants should consult the 2020 Programme Guide and supporting documents when preparing their proposal.

For those familiar with the application process, note that a **new platform will be used for applications** this year.

# **Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees**


The deadline for applications is **13 February 2020** at 17:00 (Brussels time, CET) for projects starting between 1 August and 31 October 2020. It is planned for select 47 new master programmes. In contrast to 2019, the 2020 Call will not be inviting proposals for EU-Japan joint Master programmes.

### **Capacity Building in Higher Education**

The deadline for applications is **5 February 2020** at 17:00 (Brussels time, CET). CBHE projects can start on **15 November 2020 or 15 January 2021**, and run for 24 or 36 months.

### **Budget envelopes and Partner Countries**

The 2020 budget will be broadly similar to the previous call's budget, both in terms of overall size and in terms of the number of envelopes. In addition to **10 budget envelopes** covering each region of the world, the European Commission is providing additional funding for



Georgia and Ukraine. Uruguay and Chile may once again take part in – but not coordinate - CBHE projects. See the Programme Guide for the conditions applying to their participation.

#### **Jean Monnet activities**

The deadline for applications is **20 February 2020** at 17:00 (Brussels time, CET) for projects starting on 1 September 2020.

Priority countries/territories eligible to apply for an additional €3.5 million Partnership Instrument (PI) budget are (indicatively): Australia, Canada, China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, New Zealand and South Africa.
