You can get to the hotel from the airport in just 20 minutes by taxi.



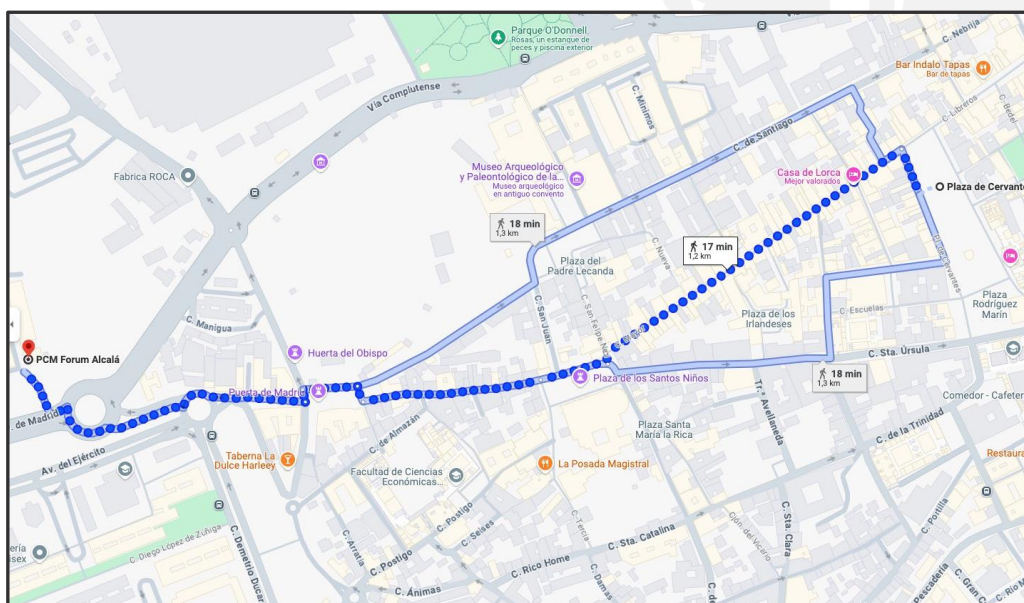
