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PEACE – «Participation Erasmus Alumni for Civic Engagement» is a Long Term cooperation activity coordinated by Italian Erasmus+ National Agency INDIRE on increasing civic, political participation among EU citizens.

Why civic engagement?

- Low interest in the social, civil and political life of the host nation
- International employment is still found to be uncommon today
- Permanency considered «Temporary»
- Presence of barriers towards integration (for example language barriers)

LTA PEACE goals


Reinforcing networks and links with territories

Pillar 1

Supporting active citizenship and ethics in lifelong learning. Promote new opportunities for people's social and civic engagement through formal and non-formal learning activities, as well and to raise awareness on the EU common values - human dignity, freedom, democracy, inclusion, and solidarity according to the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights. media literacy.
