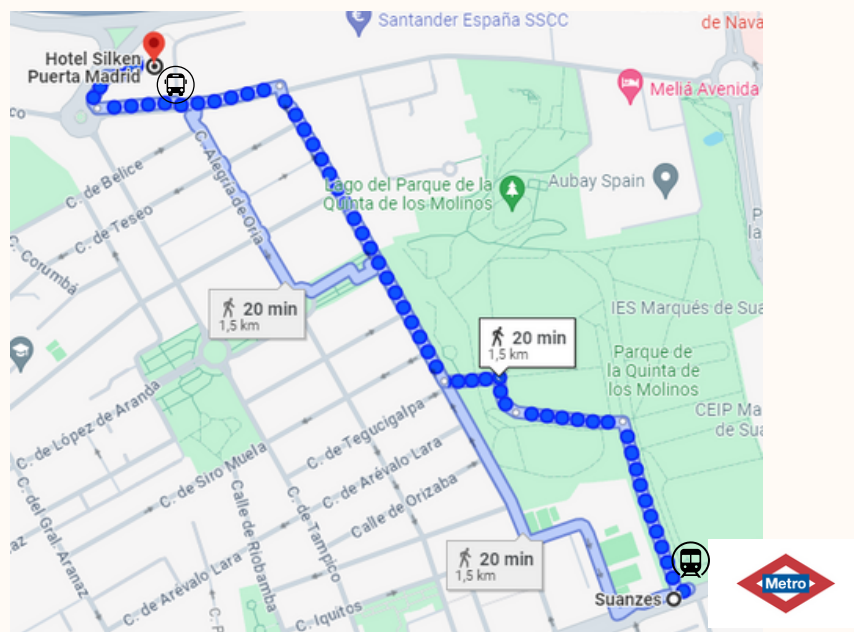
You can get to the hotel from the airport in just 10 minutes by taxi.

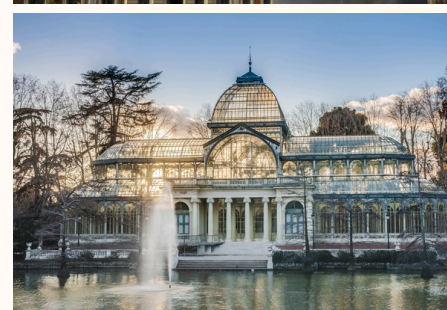
