The UGR has 7 campuses in 3 cities: Granada (5), Ceuta (1) and Melilla (1) as well as a Virtual Campus



Administrative issues (Master)

Master student candidate

Bachelor (and sometimes: Language requirements, Entrance examination)

Application submission:

Only one phase: end of January

Enrollment:

Ordinary phase: October



Administrative issues (Master)

Students who possess a foreign university degree that has not been recognized in Spain as equivalent to a bachelor's degree and which entitles them to pursue postgraduate studies in their country of origin must provide the following documents:

- NIE, Certificate of Right of Residence, European Union Citizen Card or, failing that, passport.
- Document indicating any grant awarded.
- The title claimed must also be included.
- This document certifies that the applicant holds a Bachelor's degree issued by an official body in their country of origin, which qualifies them to pursue postgraduate studies in that country.
- The official academic transcript must certify the duration of the studies, expressed in credits or months, and the grades obtained in the subjects. If applicable, the final project or thesis that allows access to the Master's degree or Master's degrees being applied for must also be included, with an express indication of the final average mark for the studies.
- This certificate should state both the minimum passing grade for the subject and the maximum grade that can be obtained.
- Additionally, all documents must be accompanied by a legal translation into Spanish.



Administrative issues (PhD)

Phd student candidate

Bachelor + Master (min. 60 ECTS) = 300 ECTS

or

Bachelor + Master + additional documentation issued by your home university

Application submission:

Ordinary phase: July-October

Extraordinary phase: September-January

Enrollment:

Ordinary phase: November-December

Extraordinary phase: March
