

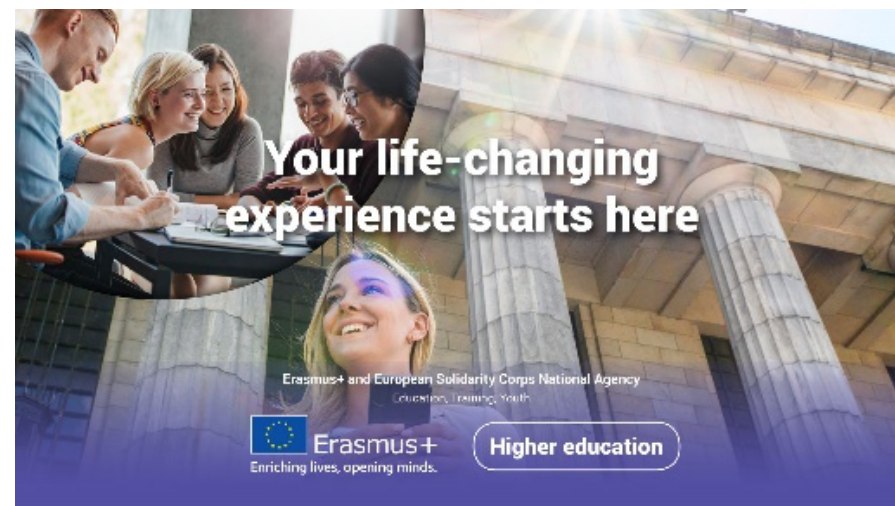

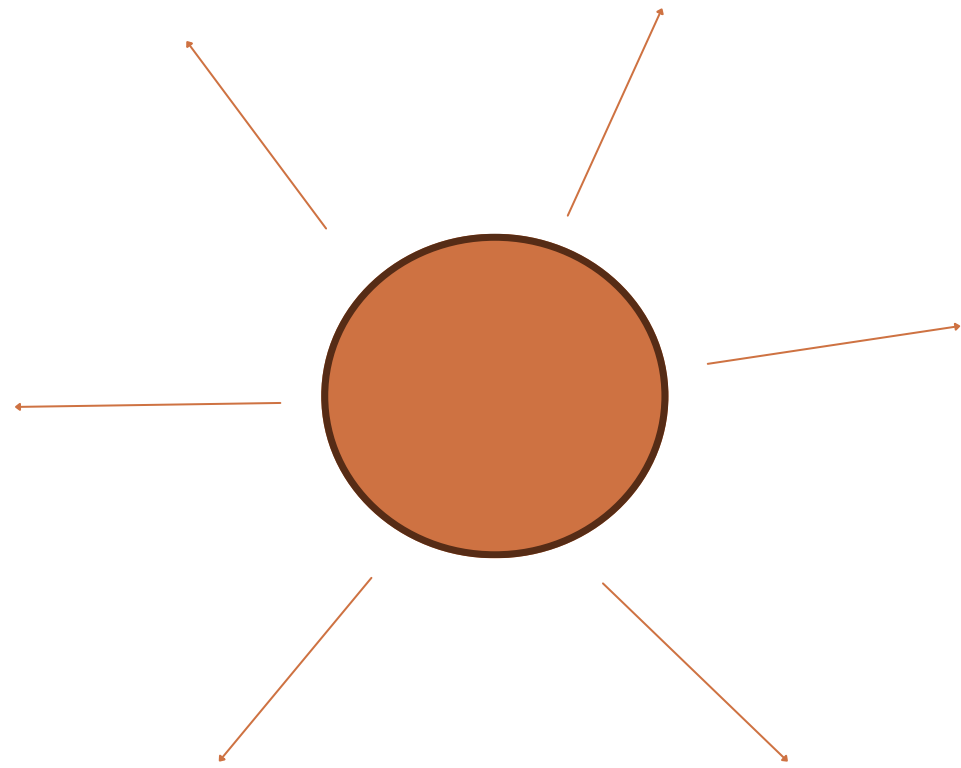

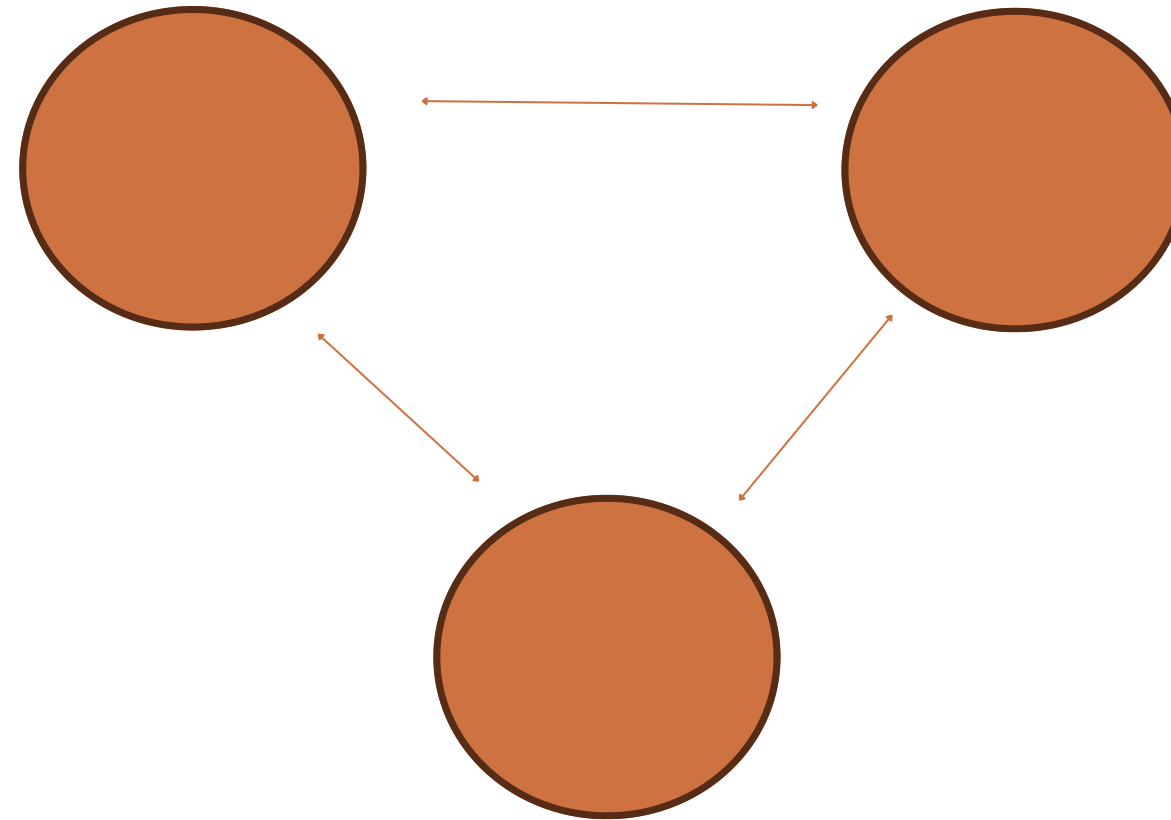

KEY ACTION I - OVERVIEW

Project structure

- Mobility projects organised by institutions
- Includes: planning, preparation, implementation, follow-up
- Clear learning outcomes must be defined

Who applies

- Organisations (schools, universities, NGOs, institutions)
- Individuals **cannot apply directly**

Participants

- Students, learners, youth, Staff, educators
- Must be selected and supported by the organization

International dimension

- Activities usually involve **mobility abroad**
 - Sending and receiving organisations required
-  KAI is institution-based but participant-focused

KEY ACTION 2 - OVERVIEW

Partnership requirement

- Projects implemented by **international consortia**
- Minimum **2–3 organisations from different countries**
- Project duration 6-36 months (depending on project type)

Eligible applicants

- Schools, universities, NGOs
- Public institutions, companies, VET providers

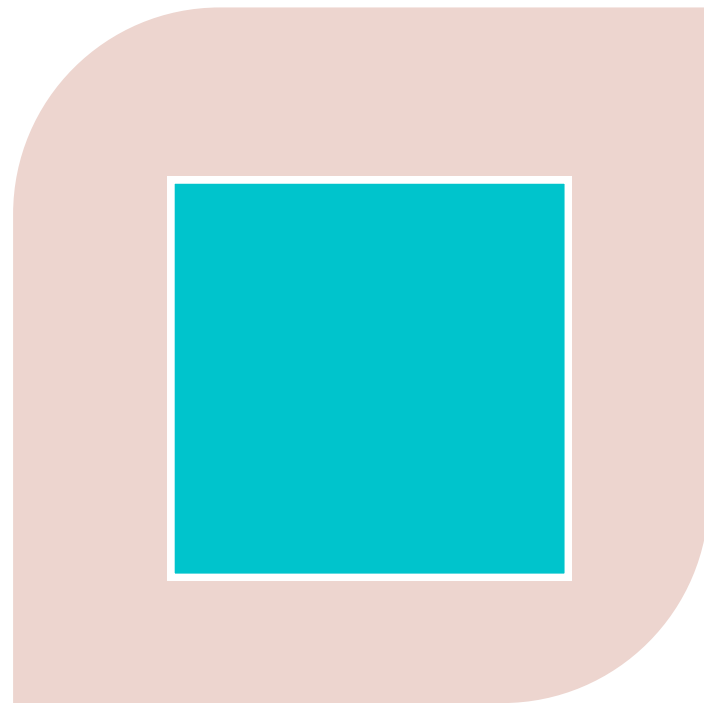
Highlights of the action:

- Needs ☒ Activities ☒ Outputs ☒ Impact



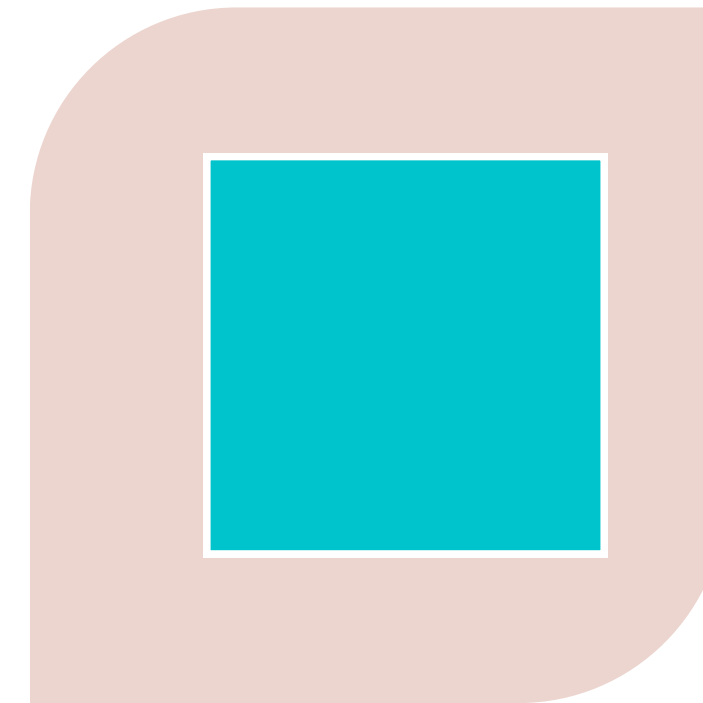
Focus on **innovation, capacity building, networking**

KEY ACTION 2 TYPES OF PROJECTS



SMALL SCALE PARTNERSHIPS

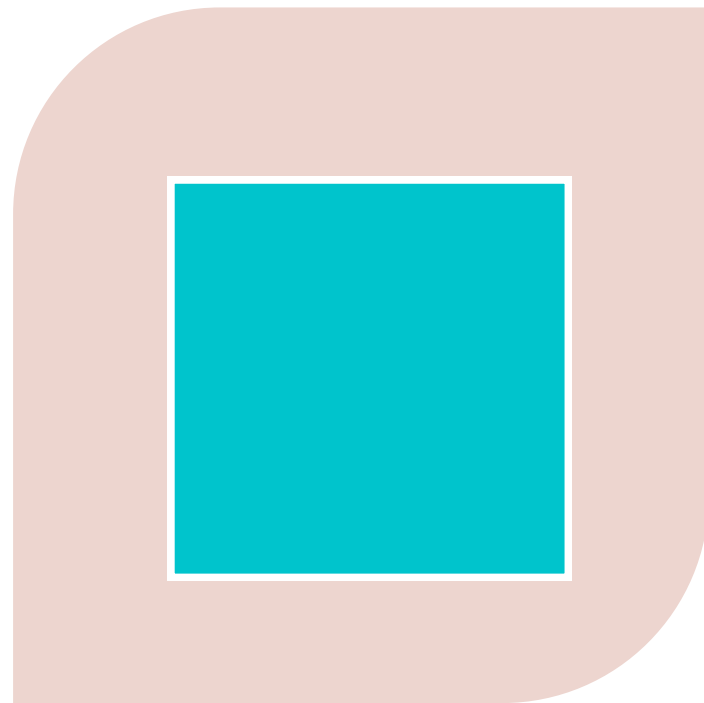
- newcomers and grass-root organisations
- supporting the inclusion of target groups with fewer opportunities
- combining exchange of experiences and local dimension
- simple settlement rules



COOPERATION PARTNERSHIPS

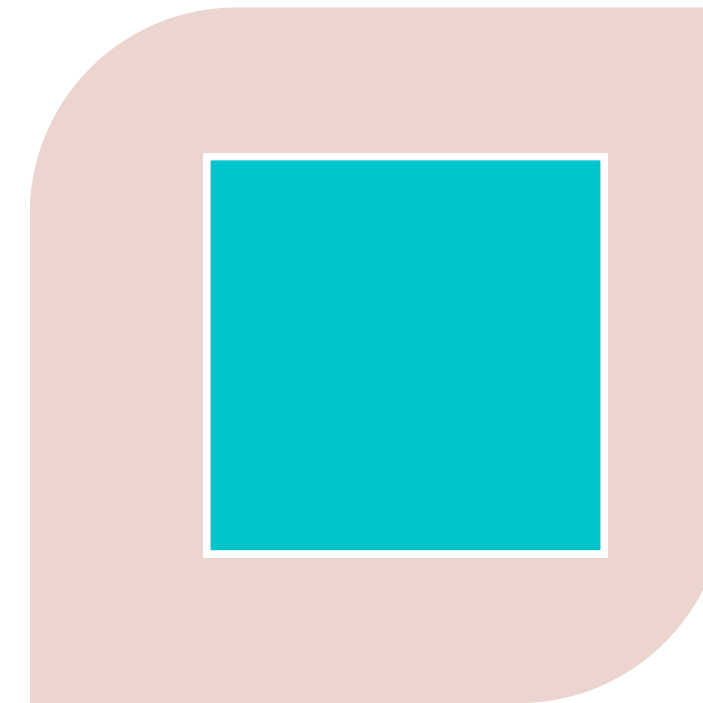
- organizations operating on a larger scale
- strengthening the quality of implemented activities
- creating a cooperation network
- development and implementation of innovative solutions

KEY ACTION 2 TYPES OF PROJECTS



SMALL SCALE PARTNERSHIPS

- min. 2 organisations from Programme Countries
- lump sum 30.000 EUR or 60.000 EUR
- SCH, ADU, VET (not HE!)



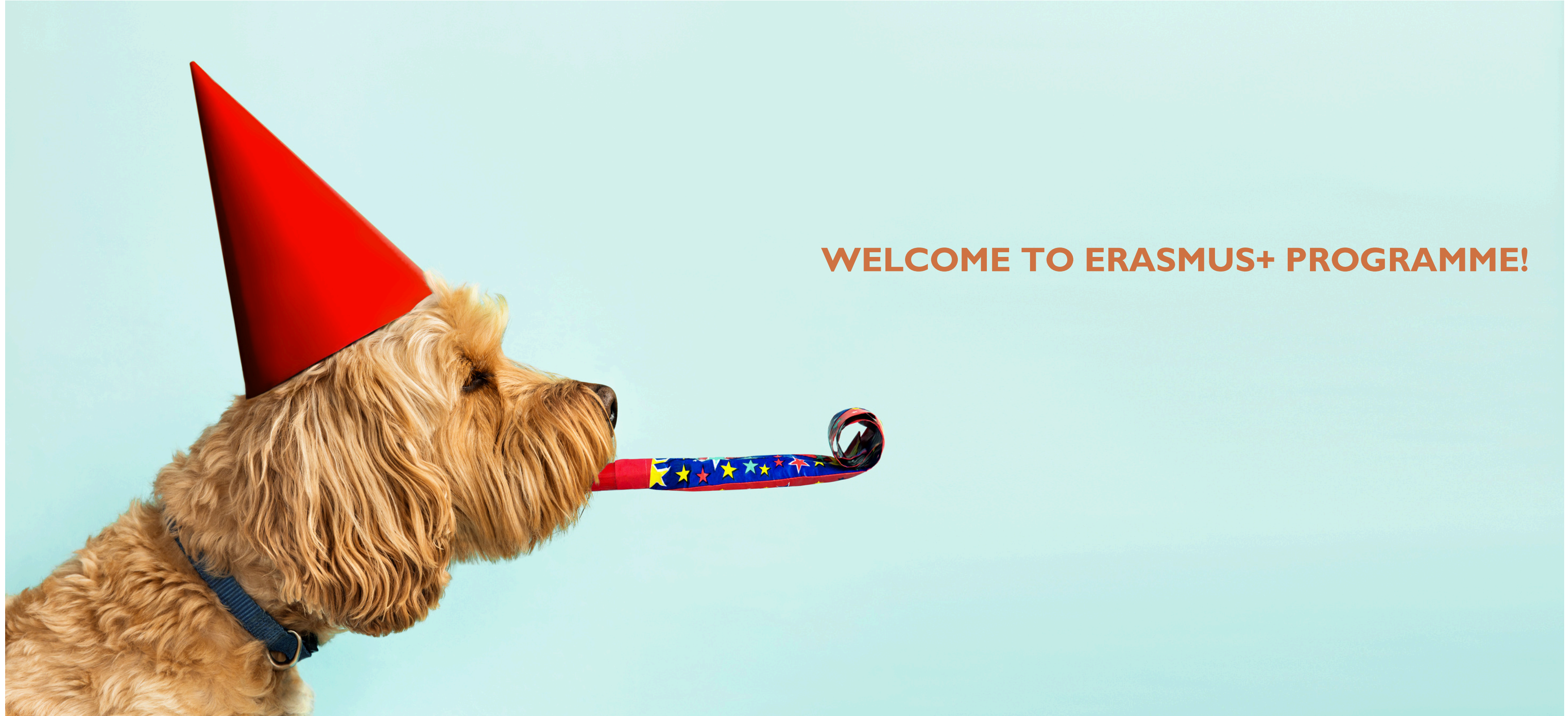
COOPERATION PARTENRSHIPS

- min. 3 organisations from eligible countries
- lump sum 120.000, 250.000 or 400.000 EUR
- tangible results (tools, methods, outputs)
- all sectors
