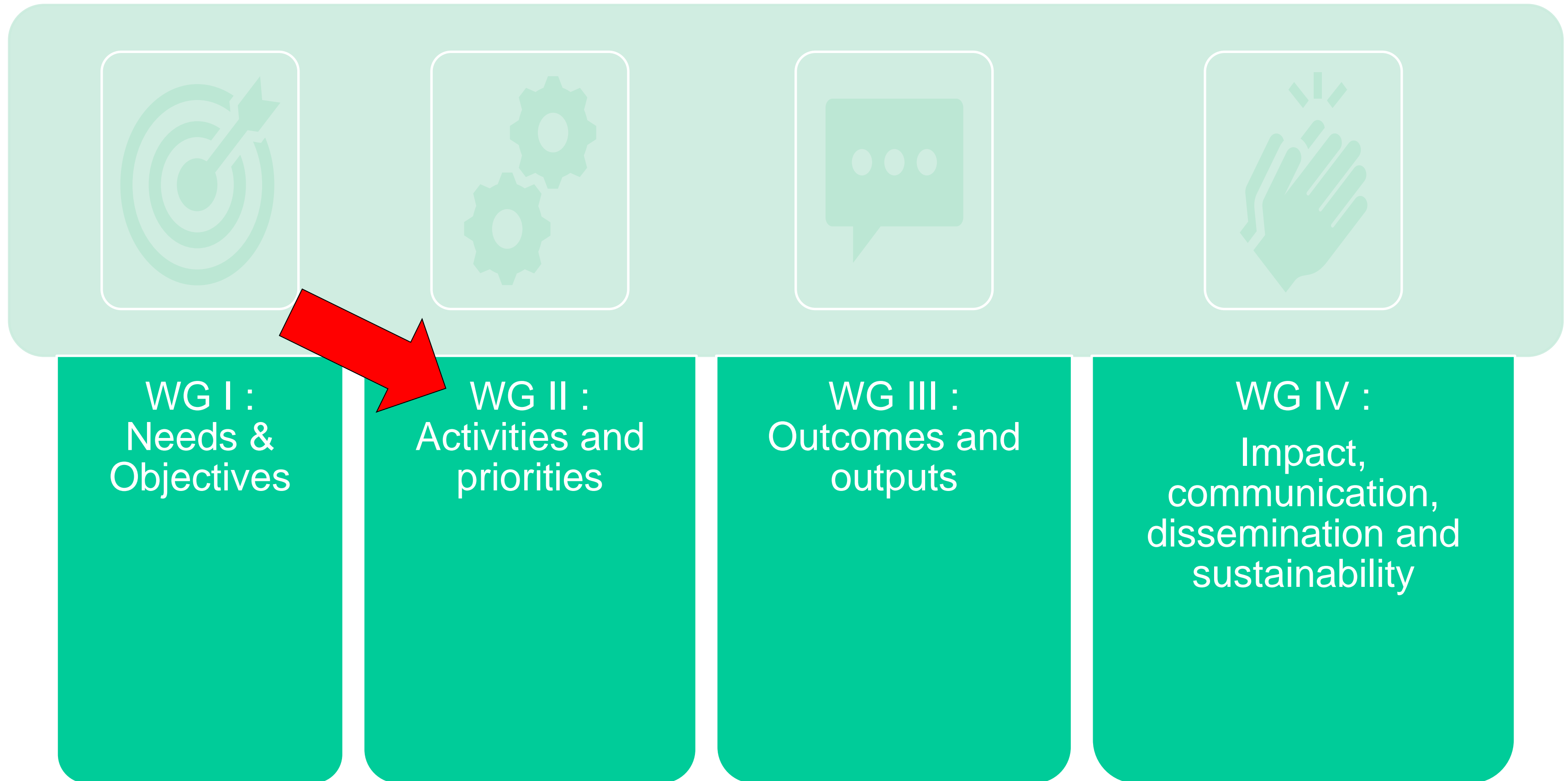

 Who will **participate**?

 How will we ensure **inclusion**?

 What **impact** do we expect?

 Can this practice **continue** after the project ends?

1 STUDENT MOBILITY



PURPOSE

Connect students with European partners and learn through participation.

ACTIVITIES

- Group mobility
- Partner school activities
- International exchanges

2 STAFF MOBILITY



PURPOSE

Improve educational practices and democratic participation.

ACTIVITIES

- Training courses
- Job shadowing
- Teaching assignments abroad



EXAMPLES

- Participation training
- Observing effective student councils
- Inclusive democratic practices

3 OTHER ACTIVITIES



PURPOSE

Extend participation beyond mobility.

ACTIVITIES

- Guest experts
- Local school actions
- eTwinning projects
- Virtual exchanges



EXAMPLES

- Participatory budgeting
- Class assemblies
- Awareness campaigns
- Online collaboration with European partners

1 PARTICIPATION IN DEMOCRATIC LIFE



THIS PRIORITY FOCUSES ON:

- ✓ Promoting active citizenship
- ✓ Encouraging critical thinking
- ✓ Increasing student participation in decision-making
- ✓ Strengthening understanding of European values

EXAMPLES



2 INCLUSION & DIVERSITY



THIS PRIORITY AIMS TO:

- ✓ Ensure that everyone can participate
- ✓ Give a voice to underrepresented groups
- ✓ Reduce barriers to engagement
- ✓ Create more equitable learning environments

3 DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION



THIS PRIORITY PROMOTES:

- ✓ Responsible use of digital technologies
- ✓ Digital citizenship
- ✓ Media literacy
- ✓ Combating misinformation and fake news

4 ENVIRONMENT & SUSTAINABILITY



THIS PRIORITY ENCOURAGES:

- ✓ Student involvement in sustainability decisions
- ✓ Environmental responsibility
- ✓ Youth leadership for sustainable development

<p>4. Which priority does it address?</p>	<p>5. Which objective does it support?</p>	<p>6. What impact do you expect?</p>

Plan it, design it, make an **impact!**

EXAMPLE

NEED: Students have little involvement in school decision-making.

OBJECTIVE: Increase student participation in school life.

ACTIVITY: Job shadowing in a school with an active student council, followed by the creation of a school parliament.

PRIORITY: Participation in Democratic Life.

EXPECTED IMPACT: Students become more engaged and take an active role in shaping school decisions.



FINAL REFLECTION

REMEMBER:

A good Erasmus+ project is not the one with the most activities. It is the one in which every activity has a **clear purpose** and **contributes to the change** your school needs.

ASK YOURSELVES:

“Why this activity and not another?”

If you can justify the answer, you are building a **strong and coherent Erasmus+ project.**
