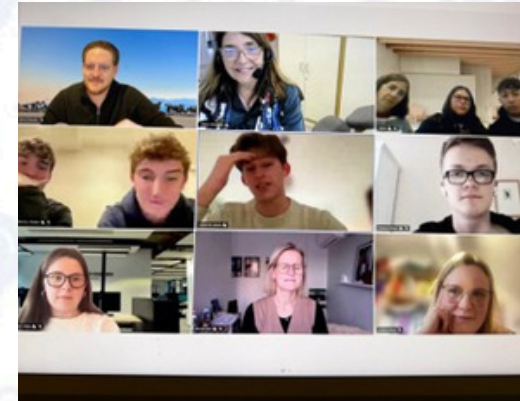


Why the projects are developed?
