



Supporting Transitions - the role of career guidance

Profile of participants: CGC practitioners active in SE, VET, AE and HE institutions, teachers, school psychologists, pedagogues, career counsellors and other professional associates. It is preferable that participants have experience in CGC and basic knowledge of the field. Active participation in English is expected from participants.

Themes and goals of the event: This seminar will focus on career guidance and counselling (CGC) activities designed to support students' transitions from one level of education to another and from education to labour market. Career transitions have certain similarities at different levels of education. These common elements, as well as specificities related to each level, will be explored in expert presentations and interactive workshops. Participants will have the opportunity to acquire knowledge of some key concepts in the field. CGC practitioners from different educational institutions will gather to discuss different approaches, common challenges and ways to support students through cross-sectoral and international cooperation.

Expected results:

- Achieving a better understanding of the students' and learners' needs in transitions.
- Gaining new ideas for activities, tools and projects to support students and learners in transitions.
- Networking, building partnerships and exchange of ideas and best practices between participants
- Raising awareness of the importance of the cross-sectoral cooperation in the field of CGC in order to ensure continuous opportunities and support to students and learners on each educational level and pathway
