## Who are we?

The **Spanish Service for the Internationalization of Education** (SEPIE) is an autonomous agency under the Ministry of Science, Innovation, and Universities, acting as the National Agency for the internationalization and management of the Erasmus+ programme in Spain. Therefore, SEPIE serves as the single, centralized point of contact between the 96 universities that make up the Spanish University System as a whole and foreign governments or institutions—both public and private—and its functions include contributing to the international promotion of Spanish higher education worldwide.

Among its activities, the following stand out:

- The **dissemination and promotion** abroad of the educational and research offerings of Spanish universities and research centers.
- **Advising and supporting** the mobility and reception of foreign students, professors, and researchers in Spain, as well as Spaniards abroad.
- The preparation of **reports, studies, and analyses** on the state of Spanish education and its level of internationalization.
- The creation of **actions and procedures** that enable the attraction of international talent to Spanish universities.

## Why choose Spain?

- Spain is the **top Erasmus+ destination** in Europe, chosen each year by tens of thousands of international students attracted by its academic quality and lifestyle.
- The Spanish University System is part of the European Higher Education Area, along with 46 other countries, which facilitates the mobility of students, professors, and researchers, as well as the recognition of degrees and studies.
- Spanish, the **official language in 21 countries** worldwide, is the second most spoken language in the world by number of speakers (around 600 million).
- The Spanish University System is recognized for its **international quality**, with representation in global rankings such as ARWU, QS, THE, and Taiwan.
- Spain offers a wide **variety** of degrees in Spanish and English, with more than 800 English-Taught Programmes.
- Spain is the 3rd country in the world for **quality of life** and one of the **safest** countries in the world.
- Many Spanish academic programmes are **recognized** by leading international accreditation agencies.
