Osnabrück Declaration

- ➤ Aims at revitalizing the **Copenhagen process** and continuing the tradition of Declarations/Communique
- > Complements the VET Recommendation by defining concrete actions for the period 2021-2025 at both national and EU level
- > **Endorsed** by Ministers in charge of VET (EU-27, EEA countries, candidate countries), European Social Partners and Commission
- > Supported by EU **VET providers**' associations and **learners**' representatives (OBESSU/EAN)
