

Global approach

- A global greenhouse gas emission increase since 1980
- 6th extinction and loss of biodiversity
- Climate change and more natural disasters
- Over the last century and a half, the global temperature has risen by 1.1°C
- First objectives for 2030

International framework

2015: Paris Conference (COP21) and Paris Agreement. 195 countries and the EU agree on limiting the temperature increase to 2°, taking into account the needs and means of the signatory countries

2015: 17 Sustainable Development Goals, adopted by all UN Member States in 2015, as part of the <u>2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development</u>: a <u>holistic approach</u> to end poverty, protect the planet and improve the lives and prospects of everyone, worldwide. Supported by <u>detailed indicators and reporting mechanism</u>

2017: the USA leaves the Paris Agreement

2021: the US come back in the Paris Agreement, COP-15 on the Convention on Biological Diversity, Glasgow Climate Change Conference (COP26, coorg UK + IT)

April 2022: the Climate Experts of the IPCC published a new report dedicated to solutions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and to limit global warming to 1,5 degrees




